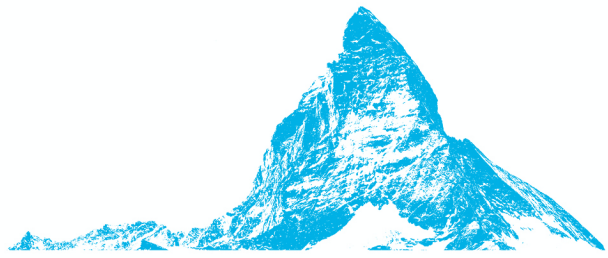


## SCR'23 Abstract Raffle TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Eligibility:** The SCR'23 Abstract Raffle is open to Abstract Submitters for the SCR'23 in Davos. Entrants must be 18 years of age or older as of their date of entry in this promotion in order to qualify. This Abstract Raffle is subject to federal, state, and local laws and regulations and void where prohibited by law.
- 2. Agreement to Rules:** By entering this Abstract Raffle, the Entrant (“You”) agrees to abide by the Organizer’s Official Rules and decisions, which are fully and unconditionally binding in all respects. The Organizer reserves the right to refuse, withdraw, or disqualify any entry at any time at the Organizer’s sole discretion. By entering this Abstract Raffle the Entrant represents and warrants that the Entrant is eligible to participate based on eligibility requirements explained in the Official Rules. You also agree to accept the decisions of the Organizer as final and binding as it relates to the content of this SCR'23 Abstract Raffle.
- 3. SCR'23 Abstract Raffle Entry Period:** This raffle begins on October 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022 and ends on December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022 (“Entry Period”). To be eligible for the Abstract Raffle, entries must be received within the specified Entry Period.
- 4. How to Enter:** Eligible entrants can enter The SCR'23 Abstract Raffle by submitting an abstract for the SCR'23 in Davos at <https://congress.sgr-ssr.ch/abstracts/>. As a participant, your entry must fully meet all SCR-Abstract requirements, as specified under <https://congress.sgr-ssr.ch/abstracts/>, in order to be eligible to win a prize. Incomplete entries or those that do not adhere to the Official Rules or specifications will be disqualified at the Organizer’s sole discretion.
- 5. Prizes:** The Winner(s) of the SCR'23 Abstract Raffle (the “Winner”) will receive One of 5 Tickets for the Society Evening at the SCR'23 in Davos. The actual/appraised prize value may differ at the time the prize is awarded. The prize(s) shall be determined solely by the



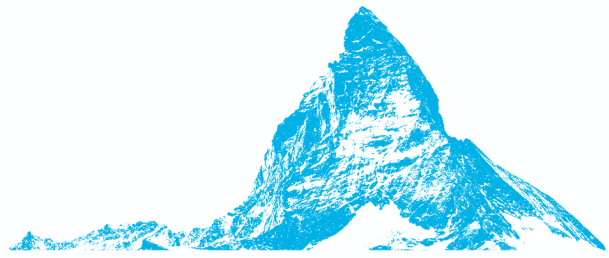
Organizer. There shall be no cash or other prize substitution permitted. The prize is non-transferable. The Winner, upon acceptance of the prize, is solely responsible for all expenses related to the prize, including without limitation any and all local, state, and federal taxes. The Winner shall not transfer assignment of the prize to others nor shall the Winner request the cash equivalent or prize substitution.

6. **Odds:** The total number of eligible entries received determines the odds of winning.
7. **Selection and Notification of Winner:** The Winner will be selected by a random drawing under the supervision of the Organizer. The Organizer will notify the Winner(s) by e-mail on February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023. The Organizer is not responsible for nor shall have no liability for Winner's failure to receive notices due to email security settings that may cause notifications to be marked as spam or junk email. Nor shall be Organizer be liable for the Winner's provision of incorrect or otherwise non-functioning contact information. Receipt of the prize (offered in the SCR'23 Abstract Raffle) by the Winner is upon the condition of compliance with any and all federal, state, and local laws and regulations. IF THE WINNER VIOLATES ANY OF THESE OFFICIAL RULES, THE WINNER (AT THE ORGANIZER'S SOLE DISCRETION) WILL BE DISQUALIFIED, AND ALL PRIVILEGES AS WINNER WILL BE IMMEDIATELY TERMINATED.
8. **Terms & Conditions:** In its sole discretion, the Organizer reserves the right to modify, suspend, cancel, or terminate the SCR'23 Abstract Raffle should non-authorized human intervention, a bug or virus, fraud, or other causes beyond the Organizer's control, impact or corrupt the security, fairness, proper conduct, or administration of the SCR'23 Abstract Raffle. The Organizer, in the event of any of the above issues, may determine the Winner based on all eligible entries received prior to and/or after (if appropriate) the action taken by the Organizer. Individuals who tamper with or attempt to tamper with the operation or entry process of the Abstract Raffle or website or violates these Terms & Conditions will be disqualified by the Organizer in its sole discretion. Attempts by any entrant to deliberately damage any website or undermine the legitimate operation of the SCR'23 Abstract Raffle may be a violation of criminal and civil laws.
